

Unable to Collect Results in Person?

In the event that you are unable to collect your results you must either:

1. Arrange for someone else to collect them for you – you will need to write a note giving permission for a named person to collect your results on your behalf. They will need to hand it in when collecting your results.

or

2. Provide a self-addressed envelope (SAE) to The Exams Officer so that your results can be posted to you.

Unfortunately, results cannot be given over the phone, nor e-mailed to you.

Staff will be on hand to help you with any issues that may arise on the day. It is important that you do not leave the site until these have been resolved.

Exam certificates

Exam certificates will not be available until December 2018. Please make sure you collect them before December 2019. Note that it is your responsibility to collect them. They are valuable documents that employers and educational institutions will want to see in the future. Schools have strict guidelines that we have to adhere to and are required to keep certificates for twelve months, after which they must be destroyed
